Motion 1 Minutes	<i>Resolved</i> that the minutes of the previous executive committee meeting held 16 August 2010 be adopted.
	Matters arising:
	 Unit 161 – ventilation issued have been resolved. The timer controlling the fan was repaired. Terry Thompson – mechanical engineer has been engaged by the Executive Committee to access the building's plans with North Sydney Council and to carry out visual inspection of the equipment on the roof. Thus far he has established that not all fans appear to be fit for purpose. A detailed findings report is pending.

Motion 3 Strata Mangers report & Correspondence	The strata managers report was received and discussed. The Executive Committee approved the renewal of the gym equipment maintenance agreement with the Firm on the same terms and conditions as last year's contract.
Motion 4 Committee Reports	 Operations – received and discussed. Works – received and discussed. Communications Upgrade: The project has been delayed by 10 days due to lack of available materials. All hallway fibres have been installed other than in foyer 10 level 5 and foyer 9 level 5 needs rework. 19 units have not yet responded to the pre-installation survey requests. Despite some slippage in the schedule the project remains forecast to complete on time and budget at end of October.
